

# Davis-Besse Atomic Energy Camporee

## Rules and Regulations

1. Lights Out will be at 10:00 p.m. on Friday. This is necessary due to the amount of material we must cover on Saturday and the number of individuals going through the classes.
2. Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station is located on a federal wildlife area. Disturbing the local wildlife will not be tolerated.
3. No one shall enter restricted areas. Restricted areas will be communicated to the Troop Leaders on Friday and are noted by signs on doors. When in doubt, as a facilitator!
4. The following materials are NOT authorized on Nuclear Plant property:
  - a. Weapons (guns, axes, bows, knives, etc.)
  - b. Drugs and alcohol.
5. Any prescribed medication must be in the original prescription bottle/container.
6. Each Troop is responsible for transporting their people to/from Davis-Besse on Saturday. Car or vanpooling is desirable. All vehicles and personal items brought onto Nuclear Plant property are subject to search by Security. The Company reserves the right to search your person, personal property and vehicle. REFER to #4, make sure your vehicle complies.
7. Troops will camp at Camp Sabroske, which is located approximately 4 miles west of Davis-Besse off of Duff-Washa Road. Tents shall be erected only in areas designated by the Camporee Staff. Sod must be replaced if a fire is built on the ground. Camp Sabroske will be kept neat and clean at all times. Trash containers will be provided for your use.
8. We will be using rooms in several buildings which will be used on Monday following the camporee. Please ensure trash is picked up and the rooms are clean before leaving. Snacks and soft drinks are not allowed in classrooms. Adults are requested to monitor Scouts for proper behavior at all times. Leave No Trace Principles apply!
9. The site phones in buildings and office areas are off-limits during the Camporee. Cell phones are allowed in all areas you will be in. Scouts should restrict use of electronic devices to breaks between activities.
10. Violation of any written and/or verbal rule while on Nuclear Plant property will result in the offending Scout being escorted to Security, where the parent/guardian will be informed of the need to immediately pick up the Scout.
11. Camp Sabroske will be unattended for most of the day on Saturday. **DO NOT** leave unnecessary items or valuables in tents.
12. All adults must bring picture identification with them (Driver's license preferred).
